the food gets cold*

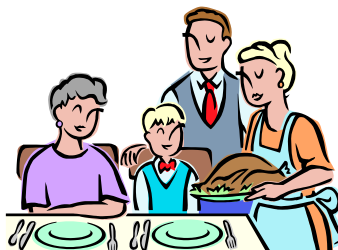
*But Lord, I'd like to take a few
